AMANGALLA

GALLE, SOUTH, SRI LANKA

In the historic port of Galle, Amangalla lies within the ramparts of Sri Lanka's 17th-century Galle Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Offering views of the Fort and harbour on one side and the hotel's gardens and swimming pool on the other, the historic residence presents 28 Guestrooms and Suites, the two-storey, free-standing Garden House, a tranquil spa and a number of gracious dining venues. Combining the Sanskrit-derived word for 'peace' with galla, the Sinhalese word for the town of Galle, Amangalla reveals the Fort's daily activities and rich legacy, its narrow streets lined with buildings from the Dutch and British colonial eras.

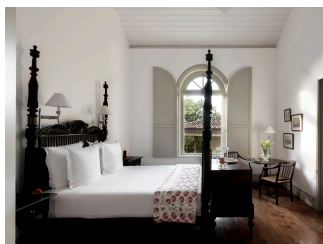

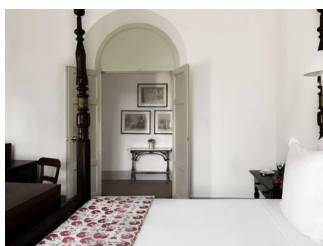

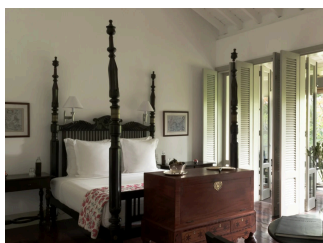
BEDROOM

Overlooking the Dutch-colonial Groote Kerk (Great Church), Bedrooms feature jackwood floors and elegant colonial-influenced furnishings.



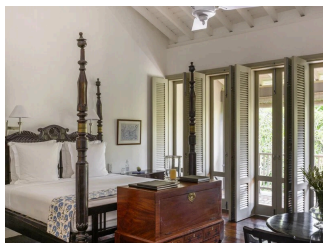
GARDEN BEDROOM

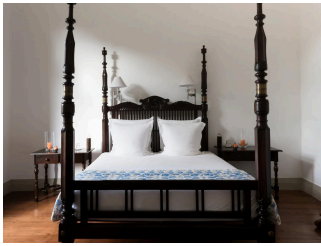
VERANDAH CHAMBER

Extending to 80 square metres (861 square feet), Amangalla Suites overlook the fort ramparts and the harbour through the leaves of Para rubber trees.

A private space set within Amangalla's mature garden, the 151.5-square-metre (1,630-square-foot) one-bedroom Garden House offers a spacious living/dining room, as well as a wrap-around balcony overlooking an immaculate garden.

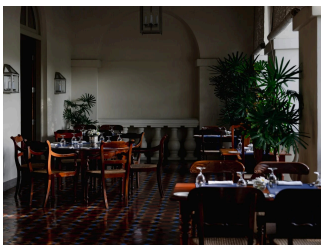

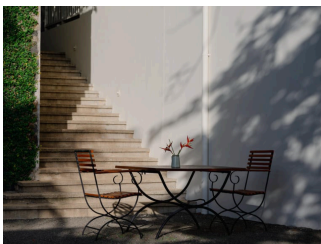
DINING ROOM

Furnished with period chairs and tables, crisp white linen and antique silverware, the high-ceilinged Dining Room rests at one end of Amangalla's magnificent Great Hall, or Zaal, as it was known in Dutch times. Soaring fin de siècle ceilings, overhead fans and chandeliers, and the veranda facing the tree-lined street create the perfect setting for exquisite Sri Lankan and international cuisine. A jazz pianist plays nightly.



VERANDA

Running the length of the hotel along Church Street, the Veranda is open throughout the day. An ideal spot for a traditional hopper breakfast while watching Galle Fort awaken, it is equally suited to a light lunch escaping the midday heat or a candlelit dinner.



POOL TERRACE

Resting alongside the resort's serene swimming pool, in the shade of mature flamboyant trees, the Pool Terrace offers breakfast and light lunches with verdant views, far removed from the bustle beyond the 200-year-old garden's walls. Spot birds as they flit through the treetops, savour a delicious traditional hopper or continental breakfast, then plan your day over a perfect cup of coffee or Ayurvedic tea.



SUNSET BALCONY

Situated on the top floor with panoramic westerly views over the rooftops of the Fort, the Sunset Balcony is drenched in sunlight in the late afternoon, and the ideal setting for a peaceful gin 'n tonic, cocktail or glass of wine to toast the end of the day. Rattan furniture, potted palms and huge windows create the dreamy ambience of a colonial conservatory.



GREAT HALL

The magnificent Great Hall, or Zaal, as it was known in Dutch times is the Lounge, Living Room and Bar all rolled into one. Open from morning for the early birds and breakfast and all day for cocktails, fresh juices, or hot and cold beverages as well as afternoon cream tea and late into the evening for night owls, Zaal has live music on most evenings.
