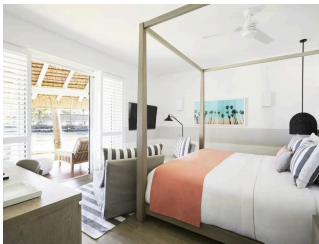
## ACCOMMODATIONS

### *DELUXE ROOM*

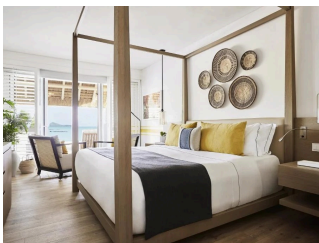

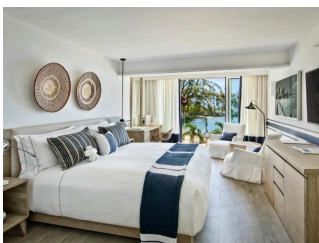

### *INTI*

Beach Rouge evolves and metamorphoses throughout the day. Lunchtime is synonymous with rosé, grilled seafood, hearty salads, and pasta—the kind of cuisine that takes you to Mediterranean shores. ### *CREOLE SMOKEHOUSE*
