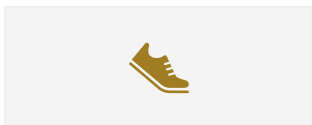
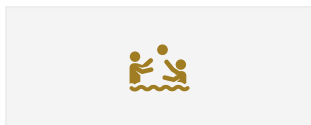

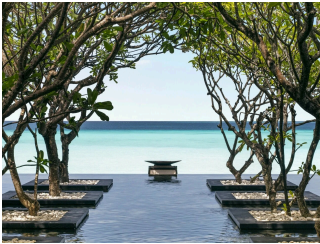
HOSHI

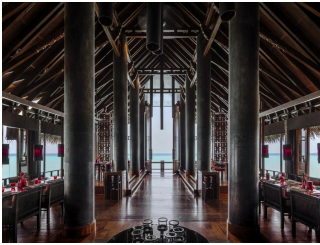
THE BEACH CLUB

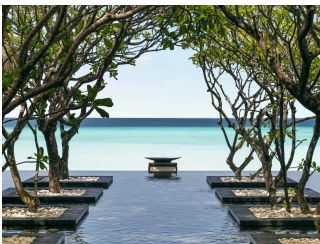
Invoking all the natural flavours from the land, farm, and sea in a charcoal oven.
